How to maximize the QBank

Anterior Superior Alveolar Block

Clinical: Anesthetizes the maxillary canine, central and lateral incisors, and mucosa above these teeth with occasional crossover to the contralateral maxillary incisors.

Landmarks: Locate the mucobuccal fold above the tooth by grasping the membrane with gauze and pulling out and down.

Procedure: Apply topical anesthesia to site, insert needle into the intersection of the mucobuccal fold and the apex/center of the canine at a 45-degree angle, and advance the needle approximately 1-1.5 cm. Aspirate, slowly inject 2 mL of local anesthetic and massage for 10-20 seconds.


